GOLF COURSE REPORT

In 2015, the Round Lake Golf Course looked very different than it does today. Both its reputation and its upkeep were in decline. The course was abandoned and no longer served as a valuable community asset. The image below reveals how hard work and Christ-like customer service can bring about transformation. The community is returning to play, and they notice the spirit with which we operate. Golfers who left 10 years ago have come back. In 2020, three more leagues will be added. We are blessed to see how God continues to move through this ministry as we reach into the community.

^{*}Since 2016, property taxes and insurance have both been included in the golf course budget. It is important to note, however, that the camp would have purchased the golf course property even if it did not intend to operate it as a golf course. As a result, the property tax and insurance expenses should not be included in the operational expenses of the golf course as they are tied into the property itself rather than into the golf course as a business. To keep the comparison chart accurate to operations, those two expenses have been removed from past actual in the Adjusted Expenses line.
