JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Position Reports To:** RLCC Program Director, Ben Strouse.

**Age:** Must be 18 years old or a graduated senior in High School.

**Summer Hours:** 10 1/2 weeks (9 weeks of Camp and 1 1/2 staff training week)

We require our lifeguards to train and certify for First Aid, CPR and Life Savings. You must have this certification completed before June 12th. Round Lake will pay for this training either through reimbursement or upfront. June 1st is the start of our Program Staff Training Week and will end late Friday on June 10th.

Work Week: Sunday afternoon until Friday after program duties and cleaning duties are completed, usually around late afternoon.

**Position Summary:** Under the supervision of the Summer Camp Program Director, organizes and assists in summer camp activities. Every summer program staff member will be trained in every area in order to spread the daily workload around.
