Overview

The position of Cook is hired to work in the camp kitchen during the summer camp season. The Cook is responsible for providing healthy, fulfilling meals for campers, volunteers and staff in a loving, Christian environment. Cook works directly under the Food Service Coordinator. The Cook is responsible for managing any paid kitchen staff working during the shift along with volunteers.

Job Duties

- Preparing, cooking and serving large quantities of food
- Using equipment in a safe and efficient manner, including but not limited to grill, ovens, deep fryers, dishwasher, large mixer, food slicer and coffee maker
- Cleaning camp kitchen and equipment as needed
- Maintaining a high standard of sanitation in food preparation
- Stocking pantry, storerooms, coolers and freezers
- Supervising food service workers and volunteers
- Compliant with Ohio Department of Heath Guidelines

Requirements

- **Professional:** Large quantity cooking experience preferred.
- **Personal Qualities:** Strives for good communication with campers, co-workers, volunteers and other camp personnel; projects good health habits; maintains health and stamina needed to perform job effectively; maintains self-control in stressful situations; able to follow verbal and written instructions; timeliness in work.
- **Physical Demands:** Exposed to heat from ovens, burners and steam trays; exposed to cutting and slicing equipment and machines with moving parts; standing for prolonged periods; moving heavy supplies and full pans of food weighing up to 50 pounds; exposed to high noise levels from kitchen equipment and campers at meals; required to wear protective clothing.
- Mathematical Skills: Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide in all units of measure.

Other Requirements

- Commitment to Jesus Christ as Savior and willingness to mature and grow as a Christian
- Round Lake Christian Camp is owned and operated by the Independent Christian Churches and Churches of Christ. The Camp prefers that applicants have roots to this Brotherhood.
- Capable of taking and following instructions: responding well to leadership.
- Good self-concept reflected in appearance, behavior and relationships with others.
- Use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco and non-prescription drugs is prohibited for all summer staff including their time off.
