

VIP Camper – Packing List

Round Lake Christian Camp

What to Bring

- ☺ Enough clothing for the week
- ☺ Bed sheets, pillow, blankets
- ☺ Soap & shampoo
- ☺ Toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, brush and/or comb
- ☺ 2 towels and washcloths for bathing as well as 1 beach towel for swim time
- ☺ A separate bag to hold dirty clothes (**NOT a trash bag**)
- ☺ Any medications must be placed in a clearly labeled container and given to the camp nurse at check-in
- ☺ Insect repellent
- ☺ Shaving cream and razor (if you need it!)
- ☺ Swimwear (optional)
- ☺ Sunscreen
- ☺ Money (Campers are not required to spend money at any point during camp. Campers will, however, have opportunities to purchase camp souvenirs, snacks, etc. during camp store time. Missions offerings are also collected on a strictly volunteer basis.)

What NOT to Bring

- ☹ Tobacco or Vaping products
- ☹ Alcoholic beverages
- ☹ Illegal drugs
- ☹ Stereos or “boom boxes”
- ☹ CD or MP3 Players
- ☹ iPods, iPads, iPod Touch, etc.
- ☹ Gaming devices or any equivalent
- ☹ Cell Phones

A note from the nurse . . .

Although we want our campers to have a great time, safety is our main concern. We want to be safe and accurate with all medications. Therefore, we are asking campers who have more than three medications to bring them “pre-packaged” from home. This can be in the form of labeled envelopes or a sectioned pill pack. For example, all medications due at 8:00 AM on Thursday would be in an envelope or small baggie labeled with “Thursday 8 AM” and the camper’s name –OR- in the section of the pill pack for Thursday morning. Each individual day and time meds are due should have its own package or section. Again, this is only for campers with several medications. The pill bottles will still need to be sent for identification of the medications. Thanks for your help in making this a successful week of camp!
