- Towels for swimming

- Tennis shoes and socks
- Sandals or Flip Flops
- Shower Shoes
- Toiletries
- One piece bathing suit; modest tankinis are acceptable for girls
- Bible, notebook and pen or pencil
- A water bottle that can be refilled
- Money for Missions offering
- Money for Canteen (snacks only during swim time)
- Spray On-Sunscreen & Insect Repellent
