- A pillow, twin sheets, blanket or sleeping bag (it gets chilly in the night)
- Towels for swimming
- Towels for showering
- Clothes for each day (recommended 2 outfits per day)

- Sandals or Flip Flops
- Shower Shoes
- Toiletries
- One piece bathing suit; modest tankinis are acceptable for girls
- Bible, notebook and pen or pencil
- A water bottle that can be refilled
- Money for Missions offering (recommended \$10)
- Money for Canteen (snacks only during swim time)
- Spray On-Sunscreen & Insect Repellent
